Other strategic IT initiatives under Buechel's direction include a new, single point of sale platform, Whole Foods Market's first customer loyalty program (affinity), online ordering and delivery (Instacart), mobile app platform, seamless mobile payment (Apple Pay) and a number of enhancements to the company's website. He also led the implementation of Workday, a platform aimed at automating and simplifying team member services (HR) and new labor scheduling/workforce management capabilities.

Prior to joining Whole Foods Market, Buechel spent 12 years at Accenture, where he was most recently managing director and partner in that company's retail operations practice, leading the retail channels practice for North America.

At Accenture, Buechel counseled leading retailers through strategic transformations across a broad spectrum of business and IT functions, with expertise in areas such as store operations, point of sale, mobility, IT transformation, application outsourcing, workforce management, e-commerce and tender management.
